

ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT VISA ON ARRIVAL FOR INDONESIA

Visa on Arrival (VoA) can be obtained upon arrival in Indonesia at designated airports, seaports or land border checkpoints. VoA is valid for a maximum stay of 30 days from the first day of arrival regardless of the time of arrival.

The VoA can be extended for another 30 days subject to the traveler's eligibility for sponsorship of their stay in Indonesia. Please contact the nearest local immigration office in Indonesia to extend your stay.

Requirements:

- Passport valid for at least 6 (six) months.
- Possession of return or onward ticket.

Fee: IDR 500.000,- by card (Visa, Mastercard, JCB)
